## 1. INTRODUCTION

### 1.1 Description of the Event

The **J K TYRE HIMALAYAN DRIVE - 8**, round **Error! Reference source not found.** of **Error! Reference source not found.** of 2021 JK Tyre FMSCI Indian National Regularity Run Championship (INRRC). This event will be run in compliance with the 2021 International Sporting Code of the Federation Internationale de l' Automobile (FIA), the 2021 FMSCI General Prescriptions for Regularity Run, the 2021 INRRC Specific Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and bulletins issued by the FMSCI.

The Federation of Motor Sports Clubs of India (FMSCI) is the National Sporting Authority (ASN) of the FIA in India.

Modifications, amendments and /or changes to these Supplementary Regulations will be announced only by numbered and dated bulletins issued by Organizers or the Stewards and will be pasted on the Official Notice board/s.

### 1.2 Distance

The total distance of the event is set at a distance of minimum 100 kms. and maximum of 150 kms of competition zone. However, the total travel distance including additional distance (free run) from HQ to HQ should not cross 250 kms.

**NOTE:** In case of Tie of points in the finals, the tie will be resolved as mentioned in the general prescriptions of this championship

**Championship Characteristics**

**A. INRRC:**

The National Champion will be determined by following way.

- i. Each zone (North-South-Central-East-West-North East) of the country will run number rounds as approved by the FMSCI. In case there are more than 3 rounds then the participant can decide to take part in only 3 rounds for purpose of qualification for the finals.
- ii. At the end of all rounds of the particular zone , the first 5 (five) competitors from each zone will qualify for the Final round of INRRC. Points earned in qualifying rounds by qualifiers will be zeroed.
- iii. FMSCI will post the list of zone wise Qualifiers on its website & social media channels which may include reserves who will qualify as per their standing in case any of the Qualifiers do not submit their confirmations within the date specified by FMSCI for the Finals.
- iv. The final round will be of three leg /day event, and competitors will attribute points of each leg as given in Art 6.2 of the General Prescription. The crew with the maximum number of points will be called as FMSCI Indian National Regularity Run Champion.
- v. There will be 2 (Two) categories in INRRC Final round & they are as follows:
  1. OVERALL
  2. LADIES

**B. LADIES CUP:**

- C. It is an additional category for all women team. However, they are also eligible to win in Overall Category if they register for the Championship.
  - i. At the end of all rounds, the first 3 (three) Ladies Team from each zone will qualify for the Final round of Ladies Cup. Points earned in qualifying rounds by qualifiers will be zeroed.

- ii. The final round will be of three leg /day event, and competitors will attribute points of each leg as given in Art 6.2 of the General Prescription. The Ladies Team with the maximum number of points will be called as FMSCI Regularity Run Ladies Cup Champion.

#### **D. ZONE CUP:**

Each zone (North-South-Central-East-West-North East) of the country will run the qualifying rounds of the INRRC.

The crew with the maximum number of points from each zone will be called as FMSCI INRRC ZONE Cup winner.

If feasible a Competitor can register from multiple zones. However even if they win more than one Zone Cup, they will have the right to get the Zone Cup only from one Zone of choice. It should be the same zone as described in Art. No. 2.1.2.

**NOTE:** The participants intending to participate in INRRC will have to participate in all their respective rounds. However, if a zone is having more than 3 rounds then the participant has to participate in 3 rounds for the purpose of qualifying and points from 3 rounds will only be counted for the purpose of qualification. The participant is free to participate in more than 3 rounds & in that case the points from the best 3 rounds will be taken for the purpose of qualification.

In case of zones where there will be less than 3 rounds ie either 1 or 2 rounds, Regularity Commission will have the option of 2 Wild Cards per zone only to be exercised in case there is qualification of less than 2 teams of Domiciled competitors (Both Driver & Navigator) of that particular zone & to ensure a minimum participation of 2 domiciled teams from each zone in the finals.

However, this will not be applicable for Zone Cup. The competitor will attribute points in each round as per structure of points laid down in Art. 6.2. of General Prescriptions of Regularity Run.

- 1.3.1 The driver and navigator will have to register with FMSCI as a Competitor.
- 1.3.2 If feasible a Competitor can register from multiple zones. However even if they qualify from multiple zones, they will have the right to represent only from one zone of choice.

#### **1.4 REGISTRATION**

- 1.4.1 Each competitor including Driver & Navigator and Team intending to participate in INRRC must Register individually with the FMSCI to be eligible for points.

- 1.4.2 A Competitor/Team taking part in INRRC must register their entry with the FMSCI within closing of given registration date. Registration beyond the given date may be done at the discretion of FMSCI subject to late fees as decided by FMSCI.
- 1.4.3 Once registered the competitor needs to participate in all rounds thereafter. Non participation other than force majeure, acceptable by FMSCI will entail loss of previous round points. However in all cases payment of Entry Fees mandatory. **This is in case of PRIVATEER, MANUFACTURERS OR TEAMS (WHICHEVER IS APPLICABLE).**
- 1.4.4 Any manufacturer or a team intending to participate in a championship will also need to register with FMSCI. The registration fees will be ₹ 25,000.00 per zone up to a maximum of 3 cars. Additional ₹ 10000.00 per car will have to be paid thereafter.

### 4.2 Entry Procedure

Those wishing to take part in this event must send the official entry form duly completed to the permanent secretariat at the address given in Art.2.2 as per program.

### 4.3 Maximum number of entries and classes

## 5. INSURANCE

## 6. ADVERTISEMENT AND IDENTIFICATION

6.1 It is compulsory to carry Organizers advertisements on the competition vehicle

6.2 Competitors are allowed to affix any kind of advertisements on their vehicle provided that

- It is authorized by the National Laws and FMSCI Regulations
- It is not likely to cause any offense

- It is not Political or religious in nature
- It is not conflicting with the advertisement / sponsor of the Organizer / Event
- It does not encroach upon the space reserved for plates & competition number.

## 7. DOCUMENTATION

The Entrant should produce the following for inspection at the time of submitting the vehicle for Scrutiny and Administrative Check.

Competitors are required to bring:

Entrants license / FMSCI registration no.

- Driver and Navigator competition licenses
- Driver & Navigators driving license
- Driver / Navigator PAN Card Copy
- Completion of all details on the entry form
- Special Rally cover insurance certificate
- Car insurance, registration, pollution, road tax papers
- Authorization letter from car owner other than participant.

Onus of carrying all above papers during the entire event lies with the competitor. **Failure to carry shall be reported to Steward.**

## 9. SAFETY

- Wearing** of Helmets (minimum ISI) is highly recommended & it is mandatory especially for competitors in cars with roll cage (without proper padding) **and for all where Article 8.2.2 of General Prescriptions is applied**
- Minimum** 3 points Seat belts for **all crew members** is mandatory. (4 points for cars with Roll cage)
- All** participants must be seated in seats, which face forward only.

- iv. **The bench type sideways seats may be retained but must not be occupied.**
- v. **Any competitor who is deemed unfit for reasons of health or consumption of/under the influence of alcohol or drugs shall be DISQUALIFIED.**
- vi. **Soft top vehicles are allowed subject to all crews need to wear ISI Helmets.**
- vii. **All electrical components of the vehicle must be working and the vehicle should be road worthy.**
- viii. **First Aid Box must be carried in the competing vehicle. (Ref. Appendix II–10 of General Prescriptions)**
- ix. **Mud flaps are compulsory.**
- x. **Further, all competing vehicles must comply with Article 7\* (Fire Extinguisher, Dry Powder 2kgs.), 9 (2 Nos. Rear View Mirrors), 10 (Towing Eye) of Chapter III of the Technical Regulations 4W of FMSCI. \*Mandatory for all National events, for others it is highly recommended.**
- xi. **In case the event runs in day night situation, additional lights and navigation lamps are highly recommended.**
- xii. **OE / VO silencer box is mandatory. Modification of exhaust manifold till catalytic converter only is permitted. After pre event scrutiny the Scrutineer may further check the vehicle at any point of time. Cars found violating regulations anytime/anywhere during the event shall be disqualified. If required "Add time" as per Article 17.4 of General Prescriptions shall be applicable.**
- xiii. **Fitment of gadgets of any form above 8 inches in front windshield is not permitted. (if found during running of the event shall be disqualified)**
- xiv. **The use of tinted glass and/or safety film is permitted in side and rear windows. In such case the crews as well as the contents in the car must be visible from a distance of 5 meters.**
- xv. **Mobile phones to be kept in a box, duly sealed by the organizer for emergency usage only. Onus of arranging the said box lies with the competitor. Usage of the said phone/Tampering of seal will lead to DISQUALIFICATION. However, Organizers may allow usage of Mobile phones but such usage while driving shall lead to DISQUALIFICATION.**
- xvi. **Using mobile based timing app may be allowed if it is permitted by the organizer and approved by FMSCI.**
- xvii. **Fitment of Sump guard is highly recommended.**

## 10. OTHER PROCEDURES

- 10.1 Official time to be used during the event will be that of GPS time (GMT +5.30 Hrs). This will be displayed at the time of Driver's Briefing Meeting.
- 10.2 Ceremonial Start is required if the actual start of the Event is not from a prominent location
- 10.3 Early Check-in is not permitted.
- 10.4 Service

Competitors may take service to their vehicles anywhere except the spaces/places specifically designated as 'NO SERVICE' zone. Such designated 'NO SERVICE' zones will be informed during Driver's briefing. Outside assistance by means of dummy cars or any other means for reasons whatsoever during the event, other than bringing back the car on road or moving the car out of the road shall lead to DISQUALIFICATION.

## 12.3 Prize Giving

All participants including winners of all categories must attend prize giving ceremony. Should prize winners fail to turn up at the prize giving, they shall forfeit their right to any awards (cash prizes and cups) and they shall be subject to a fine. If only one member of the crew is present at the prize giving, the penalties shall be left to the discretion of the Stewards.

Non-attendance of Participants other than prize winners, at prize giving ceremony will be reported to Stewards.

Failing to attend the annual FMSCI prize giving, the crew concerned will be subject to a fine of:₺ 20,000/

## 13. PROTEST AND APPEALS

### 13.1 Lodging a Protest or Appeal

All protests and / or appeals must be lodged in accordance with the stipulations of Articles 13,14 and 15 of the Code.

**13.2.1** If a protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of a clearly defined part of the car any additional deposit must be specified in the Supplementary Regulations of the event – or will be specified by the Stewards upon a proposal of the FMSCI Technical Delegate / Chief Scrutineer.

**13.2.2** If the protest is overruled or it is withdrawn after being brought, no part of the fee shall be returned. (Article 13.10.1 of FIA International Sporting Code).

If it is proved that the author of the protest has acted in bad faith, the FMSCI may inflict upon them one of the penalties laid down in the Code. (Article 13.10.3 of sporting code).

### 13.3 Appeals

- Within 96hrs. : ₹ 113,280/= (Rupees One Lakh Thirteen Thousand Two Hundred Eighty Only) (₹ 96,000/= +₹ 17,280/= GST)
- Competitors may appeal against decisions, in accordance with the stipulations set out in Articles 15.1 of the Code.
- Competitors have the right to appeal against a sentence or other decisions pronounced on them by the Stewards of the meeting. They must, however under pain of forfeiture of their right to appeal, notify the Stewards of the Meeting in writing within one hour of the publication of the decision, of their intention to appeal.
- The right to bring an appeal expires 96 hours from the moment the stewards are notified of the intention to appeal on condition that the intention of appealing has been notified in writing to the stewards within one hour of the publication of the decision. These grounds of appeal may be brought by fax or by any other electronic means of communication with confirmation of receipt. Confirmation by a letter of the same date accompanied by the necessary fee is required. The FMSCI will give its decision within a maximum of 30 days.
- All parties concerned shall be given adequate notice of the hearing of any appeal. They shall be entitled to call witnesses, but their failure to attend the hearing shall not interrupt the course of the proceedings.
- The confirmation of an appeal to the FMSCI must be accompanied by a fee of ₹ 113,280/= (Rupees One Lakh Thirteen Thousand Two Hundred Eighty Only).
- This fee becomes due from the moment the appellant notifies the Steward of the intention of appealing, and remains payable even if the appellant does not follow up the declared intention to appeal.
- If the appeal is rejected or it is withdrawn after being brought, no part of the fee shall be returned.
- If judged partially founded, the fee may be returned in part, and in its entirety if the appeal is upheld.

If it is proved that the author of the appeal has acted in bad faith, the FMSCI may inflict upon them one of the penalties laid down in the Code.

## 14. PENALTIES

### AT DTC/STC/SFTC

**NOTE:**

- Decision of The Judges of Fact (All Officials) shall be final and no protest on the above shall be entertained.
- Penalties for any other offence which is not covered in this SR shall be decided by the Stewards.

## 15. SPEED RESTRICTIONS

- 15.1** At any given point where there is no Government prescribed speed limit, speeds given in any speed block whatsoever will not be more than 45 KMPH in Plain and 36 KMPH in Hill sections.
- 15.1.1** However, speed in plains may be increased to 55 KMPH subject to the said zone is not more than 8 kms at length and is completely sanitized and pre approval from the Stewards is mandatorily obtained. There shall be not more than two such zones per day in an event. If such zone is planned, it has to be mandatorily mentioned in the SR. **Wearing of Helmet are mandatory for all crew members in these zones.**
- 15.1.2** Wherever the route goes through crowded areas like Educational Institution /Hospital/ Market and other narrow crowded areas, Organizer must ensure that speed limit does not exceed **20 KMPH**. If necessary, organizer should identify start and end of such zones in road book by giving specific tulips.
- 15.1.3** Mandatory 10 minutes dead time to be added to the running time at every manned railway level crossing.
- 15.1.4** In National Express/Highways and State Highways the maximum average speed shall be restricted to 10% less than the Government prescribed speed limit. This shall in no way be applicable in Hill sections.
- 15.1.5** However if the average speed given is above 45 KMPH as per Article 8.2.5 there shall be no time control in that Section as National Express/Highways and State Highways are mandatory NO CHECK ZONES.
- 15.1.6** However FMSCI on special cases may consider of having controls at National/State Highways only, subject to speeds are as per article 8.2.1 and position of the said controls are cleared by FMSCI route inspector. Such considerations shall in no way be in case of Expressways. All cost towards inspection shall be borne by the organizer.
- 15.1.7** In case the Event is terminated before Event HQ, results shall be declared at least 30 minutes after scheduled arrival time of the last competing vehicle at Event HQ. The said schedule time of arrival shall be determined as per time required to reach Rally HQ from the place of termination of Event as per prescribed speed restrictions.
- 15.2 Additional Trip Meter**  
Usage of additional trip meter as stated in article 2.13 of FMSCI General Prescription for Regularity Run 2021 is permitted. However, such usage shall attract a factor of 2.


